## Kindergarten

### Room 2

- ❖ 1 backpack-no wheels (label with your child's name)
- ❖ 1 1-inch three ring binder (label w/name)
- ❖ 2 boxes #2 pencils sharpened (**Ticonderoga** work best)
- ❖ 4 boxes of **CRAYOLA** Crayons (16 or 24 count)
- ❖ 1 bottle of Elmer's white glue (4oz size)
- ❖ 12 glue sticks
- ❖ 2 boxes of Kleenex
- ❖ 1 box of zip lock bags (sandwich, snack **or** gallon size)
- ❖ 1 box of snacks – goldfish, animal crackers, graham crackers, etc.
- ❖ If you would like to provide extra of the following it would be greatly appreciated:
  - glue sticks,
  - crayons,
  - Kleenex
  - snacks

## FIRST GRADE

### 1<sup>st</sup> Grade General Supply List

## **SECOND GRADE**

- 1 backpack
- 2 black dry erase markers
- 1 standard plastic pencil box
- 2 Boxes of crayons-24 count
- 2 dozen #2 yellow pencils, sharpened – Ticonderoga are best
- 6 Glue sticks
- 1 small bottle of white Elmer's glue
- 3 large pink erasers
- 2 red correcting pens
- 1 Box of Kleenex
- 1 Pair of scissors – Fiskar are best
- 1 Crayola watercolor paint set
- 2 pocket folders
- 2 wide-ruled spiral notebooks
- 1 large bag of individually wrapped, soft candy reward treats
- 1 one-inch hard cover binder
- 2 highlighters - yellow
- 1 package baby wipes

## THIRD GRADE

- 1 backpack labeled with your name
- 1 - 5 pack tabbed dividers (preferably plastic for durability)  
\*\* (please see labeling directions below) \*\*
- 1 zippered pencil pouch for inside binder (NO pencil boxes please)
- 1 bag of individually wrapped candy reward treats (NO chocolate or nuts)
- 1 large box of Kleenex
- 1 wide ruled spiral notebook & 1 large pack of loose leaf paper (wide ruled)
- 1 bottle of Elmer's glue
- 1 pair of medium-sized scissors (7" or 8" okay)
- 36 **SHARPENED** #2 pencils (Dixon Ticonderoga work the best)
- 24 pack Crayola crayons (NO colored pencils please)
- 4 skinny black dry erase markers (Expo low odor markers are the best)
- **GIRLS**; 1 box pencil top erasers    **BOYS**: Container of cleaning wipes
- Ziplock bags:    Girls - 1 box of sandwich size  
                          Boys - 1 box of gallon size

**\*\*Please label dividers at home as follows:**

**#1 (top/closest to front): Entry Task,**

**#2: Math,**

**#3: Writing,**

**#4: Reading,**

**#5: Social Studies/Science (or S.St./Sci.)**

## 4<sup>th</sup> Grade

- 200 sheets of wide ruled notebook paper
- 1 wide ruled spiral notebook
- 4 dozen - #2 pencils (Ticonderoga brand is preferred. Others have hard erasers, broken lead inside, or wood splits when sharpened.)
- 8 dry erase markers (black, low odor markers preferred. Labeled with name or initials).
- 12 count colored pencils
- 24 count crayons (optional)
- 2 Pink Pearl erasers
- small pencil bag
- 2 glue sticks
- 1 bottle of white school glue
- scissors
- Ziplock bags: boys = gallon size, girls-quart size
- 1 box Kleenex
- Prize box rewards: candy (no nuts), pencils, erasers, small toys.

### Additional Supplies:

Kovesday: 1 – 1 ½ in. 3 ring binder, baby wipes

Allen: 3 – 2 pocket folders, baby wipes, hand-held manual pencil sharpener

McPeak: 3 – 2 pocket folders, baby wipes

Rickenbach: 3 – 2 pocket folders

- Please stick to the items on the list because desk space is limited.
- Avoid items that may be distracting or disruptive to the learning environment such as gadget items, toys, and fancy pens, pencils, or erasers.
- Put your name on folders, notebooks, scissors, pencil bag, expo markers, and three-ring binder. This will help us return them to the right owner if they are lost.



## **FIFTH GRADE**

- 1 1 1/2-inch binder (nothing bigger than 10" x 12")
- 5 Tabbed Dividers – Label these Reading, Math, Writing, Science, Social Studies
- 2 package of loose-leaf notebook paper (college or wide-ruled)
- 3 soft cover report folders (3-prong with pockets)
- 1 pocket folder labeled "Homework"
- 2 spiral notebooks
- 2 boxes of #2 Ticonderoga pencils (sharpened if possible)
- 2 erasers
- Colored pencils (box of 24 or fewer)
- Scissors
- 2 Glue sticks
- 2-3 pens – black, blue, or red
- 2 black dry erase markers (unscented)
- 1 zippered bag (for pens, pencils, etc.) No pencil boxes.
- 1 box of tissues (don't label)
- 1 package of baby wipes (don't label)

These supplies are suggested. Your classroom teacher may ask for other supplies.
